

Activities and excursions

If you enjoy sports, it may be possible for you to visit the local sports centre; where you can swim, play racquet sports with your partner or maybe even go rock climbing or try some water sports. You may also be able to hire a bike.

Please discuss this with your teacher and they will be happy to arrange sports activities in their local area. Please note that expensive sports like horse riding and golf are not included in the excursions package.

Activities in the Local area

Your teacher will be able to let you know what activities are available in the local area. These may include a visit to the cinema or zoo, a game of bowling or mini golf or a visit to an arts and crafts centre.
